Al-Anon wishes to remind the community that help is available for anyone who needs it. They provide support to anyone whose life is, or has been, affected by someone else drinking. Anything discussed within an Al-Anon meeting is treated as confidential, including your presence at the meeting.

By attending Al-Anon Family Group meetings, individuals discover that they didn't cause the problem, and cannot control or cure it. They also learn how best to cope with their situation by switching their focus from the alcoholic to themselves.

Whatever your relationship to the drinker, whatever your story, Al-Anon can help. We hold regular meetings where members share their own experience of living with alcoholism.
